



Over the past season we have had 4 major rescues, 788 preventative actions over 4301 patrolling hours which has ensured the people who visited the beach were able to do so in safety.

This year we have finally opened our Wearing Street facility, providing much needed spaces for our thriving Club. A dedicated training and meeting room, along with a state-of-the-art gym facility, and storage for our emergency services equipment, all mean that we are able to be better equipped to respond to incidents as they arise. Sincere thanks to all involved, including those past Presidents who paved the way over the past 25 years for this to happen.

Highlights for season 2023/2024:

- 251 members competing for South Port (SA) between U8-Masters

It has been a busy year, marked by the rectification of our charity status via an SGM and the ongoing Wearing Street Project.

The audited financials cover the period from 1 May 2023 to 30 April 2024.

Cash in the bank and cash equivalents at the end of FY23 has increased by \$12,988 from last year to \$337,923 (previously \$324,935). The Wearing Street development is complete with the final payment scheduled for the 2024/25 financial year.

1. Sales:
 - a. Bar: Sales for the year had a small increase from last year to \$91,322, with cost of goods reduced to \$38,206, the bar made a profit of \$50,502. Thank you to Coral McWhinney and David 'Wal' Watt, the Bar Flies and all the volunteers for making this possible.
 - b. Apparel: Sales increased this year to \$17,368 with a profit of \$889 and closing stock at \$11,347. Great job Sally!
 - c. Canteen: An excellent year with sales of \$8,305 and profit of \$4,446. Well done Donna Logan and the volunteers!
2. Fundraising: income for FY24 \$34,539 less costs \$22,303 = \$12,236 profit – a decrease from last year. Thank you to all involved who have spent countless hours not only raising funds for our Club but also organising fun events for members and the wider community.
3. Grants: A successful year albeit less than last year \$52,355.
4. Sponsorship and Donations: A tidy sum of \$23,442 was received this season. Thank you to all who made this possible especially Richard 'Olly' Olesinski for his exceptional efforts. Donations were lower this year due to the DGR status issue, with some donations made via the Australian Sports Foundation (listed under grants for tax deductibility) and timing of payments. 6. Net Profit/(Loss): FY24 (\$33,487) FY23 \$50,717

Loss is primarily due to revaluation of the gym equipment upon its relocation to the new Wearing St facility and various reductions in income.

7. Non-Current Assets: Purchases included a senior board and ski trailer, gym equipment, 3 single skis, one double ski and patrol equipment.





Future Developments under consideration.



Have a fantastic off season... I will be freezing at the football, and I will see you in October ready for season 2024/25.







John Charles – Inducted into SLSSA’s Hall of Fame for Lifesaving!

John is an outstanding lifesaver with a distinguished career spanning nearly five decades since joining the movement as a seven-year-old in 1975.

John has impressively logged over 1100 volunteer patrol hours across Port Noarlunga, South Port, Moana and the State Emergency Operations group, which he has been a diligent member of for 37 years. Beginning as a trainee crew member in the Jet Rescue Boat service in 1987, he progressed through the ranks to become an instructor, assessor, state officer and core member in the 24-hour call team.

As the longest-serving Powercraft Officer, John has left a lasting legacy across lifesaving operations and surf sports.

His leadership abilities were quickly recognized when he was elected as the State IRB Officer from 1991-1993, taking on the massive responsibility of setting up all senior and junior carnivals. To date, he has set up the cans at countless summer carnivals and around 30 State Championships.

Furthermore, his dedication to IRB racing has been marked not just by numerous victories, but by his knowledge and advice which helped shape, innovate and develop the sport during its infancy.

John’s impact is felt nationally, having been instrumental in the development and review of various National Power Craft training manuals and programs which have been utilized by both Queensland and New South Wales Jet Boat Rescue Operations. He also collaborated on the design of SA’s current Jet Rescue Boats, and have trained and assessed over 10 JRB drivers and 30 crew members.





The financial statements cover South Port SLSC as an individual entity. South Port SLSC is a not-for-profit association incorporated in South Australia under the Associations Incorporation Act 1985 ('the Act').

The principal activity of the association for the year ended 30 April 2024 is:

Comparatives are consistent with prior years, unless otherwise stated.

1 Basis of preparation

In the opinion of the committee of management, South Port SLSC is not a reporting entity since there are unlikely to exist users of the financial statements who are not able to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs. These special purpose financial statements have been prepared to meet the reporting requirements of the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement requirements of the Australian Accounting Standards and Accounting Interpretations, and the disclosure requirements of AASB 101 Presentation of Financial Statements, AASB 107 Statement of Cash Flows, AASB 108 Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors and AASB 1054 Australian Additional Disclosures.

The financial statements and material accounting policies all comply with the recognition and measurement requirements in the Australian Accounting Standards.

2 Summary of significant accounting policies

Income tax

The association is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997*.

Revenue and other income

Revenue is recognised when the amount of the revenue can be measured reliably, it is probable that economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the Association and specific criteria relating to the type of revenue as noted below, has been satisfied.

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable and is presented net of returns, discounts and rebates.

Sale of goods

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and there is no longer any ownership or effective control over the goods.

Interest revenue

Interest is recognised using the effective interest method.

Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprises cash on hand, demand deposits and short-term investments which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value.

Property, plant and equipment

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment.

At the end of each annual reporting period, the depreciation method, useful life and residual value of each asset is reviewed. Any revisions are accounted for prospectively as a change in estimate.

Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost of inventory is determined using the first-in-first-out basis and is net of any rebates and discounts received. Net realisable value is estimated using the most reliable evidence available at the reporting date and inventory is written down through an obsolescence provision if necessary.

Impairment of non-financial assets

At the end of each reporting period, the association determines whether there is an evidence of an impairment indicator for non-financial assets.

Where this indicator exists and regardless for goodwill, indefinite life intangible assets and intangible assets not yet available for use, the recoverable amount of the assets is estimated.

Where assets do not operate independently of other assets, the recoverable amount of the relevant cash-generating unit (CGU) is estimated.

The recoverable amount of an asset or CGU is the higher of the fair value less costs of disposal and the value in use. Value in use is the present value of the future cash flows expected to be derived from an asset or cash-generating unit.

Where the recoverable amount is less than the carrying amount, an impairment loss is recognised in profit or loss.

Reversal indicators are considered in subsequent periods for all assets which have suffered an impairment loss, except for goodwill.
